We have reason to feel encouraged. Again our work during the past months is helping win a struggle of historic importance. Eight weeks ago, the Pettengill article "The Purge Comes to America" was projected across the nation. Since then, the whole country has been talking and thinking "purge" and now the people are becoming aware of the meaning of the issues which the President has raised. This time the people themselves instead of the members of Congress are rejecting executive domination.

Now if we do not let down our efforts but instead fight more vigorously than ever before, we can make this the turning point to a final and complete victory for constitutional, democratic government. Then we can direct our efforts toward sound recovery measures.
