

'Subversion' in High Office Bothers Vets

At least one Army major and one rear admiral (retired) are gravely concerned over subversive doctrines in the "White House and Federal Government" and the reported delaying of Navy work by 100 entrenched Communists.

This came to light yesterday at the Military Order of the World War convention during a discussion of Americanism schools for Army and Navy recruits. Maj. William M. Coffin of Cincinnati declared that a "paganistic-interpret it as communistic if you like—philosophy" pervades the Administration, even the White House.
