Tunney Youths Leave Gift

At White House A basket of fruit for President Rosevelt was delivered to the White House yesterday by members of the National Foundation for American Youth, to demonstrate, they said, that they do not share the "gimme" attitude of the Ameri-can Youth Congress. With their gift to the President, they presented a "loyalty" state-ment to Maj. Gen. Edwin Watson, the President's secretary, pledging support for the President and Con-gress. They also left at the White House a copy of a booklet. "How to Stop the Junior Fifth Column," with a foreword by Gene Tunney, former tower and a sponsor of the founda-tor. The delegation were Stephen Moarthur, jr., Eastern director for the Yauth Foundation; Douglass Hill of Brooklyn College; Anita An-ton, of New York University, and diriam Levine, of Hunter College. Later these members, with Mur-re Plavner, foundation director, and a dozen other students met in their Willard Hotel headquarters with officials of national and local vet-can organizations and patriotic soups. To fine Veterans of Foreign Wars, presented the group an American fag, and declared his organization would support the Youth Founda-tion, "and wills not at any time countenance the things the Ameri-can Youth Congress stands for." Thomas R. Callahan, chairman of the District American Legion's Americanism Committee, said the local legion had decided that the American Youth Congress meeting might proceed without interruption, but that later, after the AYC had spoken, the legion and other vet-eran's groups would ask a represen-tative of the Foundation to go on the radio and "give the answer of American youth to the American Conferes."
