1. American Communists would plunge the United States of America into war for the defense of Soviet Russia.

Proof: "Should the Soviet Union be attacked by Germany and Japan, it would be treason to advocate neutrality for America. The revolutionists (Communists) will have to insist that the United States enter the war on the side of the Soviet Union." These are the words of Earl Browder, Secretary of the Communist Party in the United States and vice-president of the American League Against War and Fascism. (See May 1936 issue of American Mercury, page 17, "The Red Road to War").

2. American Communists would destroy all religion in the United States. They would close all churches — Protestant, Catholic and Jewish. They would make every American boy and girl an atheist.

Proof: On page 191 of his book entitled "What Is Communism?" Earl Browder writes: "We stand without any reservations for education that will root out beliefs in the supernatural." In view of this statement on the part of the Communist candidate for president in 1936 all statements made by Communists about religious toleration are hypocritical.

3. American Communists believe in force and bloodshed and violence.

Proof: On Page 163 of his book entitled "What Is Communism?" Earl Browder writes: "The revolution does not simply happen; it must be made."

In a volume entitled "This Labor Union Racket" (written by Edward Dean Sullivan in defense of labor and in the hope that Communistic Racketeers will be driven out of American Labor Unions) Mr. William Green, president of the American Federation of Labor says: "When the Communists say revolution, they mean slaughter, destruction, terrorism, utter demolition and the creation of a Communist dictatorship under the ruins of democracy."

4. Communism would destroy all democratic rights in America as they have already done in Soviet Russia.

Proof: In article 124 of the Soviet Constitution freedom of anti-religious propaganda is permitted. *Freedom of religious propaganda is forbidden.* Only freedom of religious rite (whatever that means) is tolerated.

Religion may not be taught to anyone in Russia under 18 years of age. The Bible may not be printed and circulated in the Russian language. No religious magazines or periodicals are permitted. The United States permits freedom of religious propaganda. Communistic Russia forbids it.

In Article 125 of the Soviet Constitution, freedom of the press and assemblage and speech is guaranteed "in order to strengthen the socialist system", alone. In other words the Soviet Constitution does not grant real freedom of the press or of speech or of assemblage. No opposition press and no opposition party is permitted in Soviet Russia. Only that which favors Communism can be said or printed. This is the very denial of democracy.

On October 23, 1934, Molotov, President of the Council of the Peoples' Commissariat, said in Izvestia: "In the course of

elections no one will dare show his nose, for the dictatorship of the proletariat will strike without pity."

Molotov meant that the Communist Party would strike without pity. There is no dictatorship of the proletariat in Communist Russia. There is only a dictatorship over the proletariat by the Communist Party which represents less than one and one-third per cent of the total Russian population. In Communist Russia only 2,000,000 people are permitted to belong to the Communist Party. 168,000,000 Russians are not permitted to be Communists.

According to *Troud*, November 13, 1927: "The sole possibility with Communism is: One party is in power and all the others are in jail."

5. Communism is the enemy of the American worker and the American farmer.

Proof: Only Company Unions are permitted to exist in Russia. The government is the only employer and the government controls all unions. No Russian worker is permitted to criticize. No Russian worker has the economic right to strike. Russian workers are enslaved to a Communistic dictatorship.

Read William Henry Chamberlin's "Russia's Iron Age." Read the story of how Stalin massacred thousands of Russian peasants in the Ukraine because they protested against the forcible confiscation of their crops by the Communist government.

The average Russian worker gets between 150 and 200 rubles a month. Since, according to *Izvestia* of September 1935, butter costs 7.5 rubles a pound, the average Russian worker earns less than a pound of butter a day. No wonder the Communist government of Russia has to issue food cards and provide free medical service! No wonder that women are encouraged to work in factories! In Russia women are trained for war as well as men. In Russia women are factory-workers as well as men. The Russian worker receives a starvation wage, is only permitted to belong to a government-controlled company union, and is forbidden to strike or to complain.
