

## Sues for Divorce; Blames 'Mrs. X'



MRS. ELIZABETH DILLING, author of "The Red Network," filed a divorce suit yesterday at Woodstock, Ill., against Alber W. Dilling, a consulting engineer. She charged cruelty and adultery. Her complaint alleged that her husband had "clandestine meetings" with a "Mrs. X" in 1922 and a "Mrs. C" in 1941. A year ago, Mrs. Dilling was ejected from the Capitol after protesting aloud in the building's corridors against passage of the Lend-Lease Act.
