Hanford MacNider, pre-war vice chairman of America First, who once said no foreign power or group of powers will ever attack a prepared America, is now a colonel in the Supply Division of Gen. MacArthur's staff in Australia.

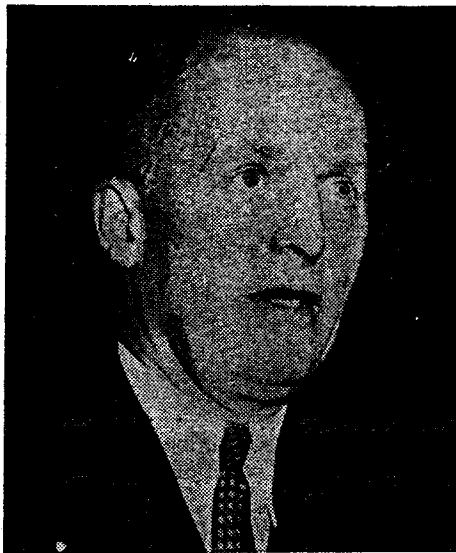
MacNider also:

¶ Charged FDR with dabbling with the "stuff of which dictatorships are born" because he asked for the power to federalize the National Guard in 1940.

¶ Shared America First platforms with Charles A. Lindbergh while Lindbergh was trying to convince America that Great Britain had no chance to beat Hitler.

¶ Was nominated to be Republican Presidential candidate in 1940 by Verne Marshall of the notorious No Foreign War Committee.

A reserve officer when the Japanese bombed Pearl Harbor, MacNider was called to duty in January.
