The readers of PM threw Milton Mayer's glove back in his face with 268 letters and telegrams and uncounted telephone calls indorsing this paper's stand on his article, The Case Against the Jews, in the Saturday Evening Post. The dissenting vote was only 27 and four of these were obviously from crackpots.

On any controversial issue, the dissenters are more likely to write than those who agree with an editor. Obviously there was no real controversy on the subject of PM's reply to the Saturday Evening Post article. So nearly everyone felt the same way about it that there was hardly an argument. Such a spontaneous and violent reaction as that recorded here is almost unheard of approval.

Hearty approval was expressed by 222 letters, leaving only a few writers who

qualified their approval.

Among the approving letters were copies of 29 sent to the Saturday Evening Post condemning the journal or cancelling subscriptions and five protest letters sent direct to Mayer.

From Brooklyn College came a joint letter of praise signed by 75 students—this in addition to the 222 approving letters mentioned above. A boys' club and a group

of high school teachers also sent group letters.

The citizens of America knew instantly what they felt about the smearing of the Goebbels line across this warring Nation's newsstands. They didn't like it, and were glad to see it called for what it was: an insult to their country and everything it stands for and is fighting for.

The letters printed here were chosen to represent, as a matter of fairness, all

the different views expressed.
