

Paper Says Plotters Had Army's New Ammunition

NEW YORK, Jan. 18.—The Brooklyn Eagle in a copyrighted article said today that a United States Army expert identified a "new type of trench mortar ammunition" in photographs of the arsenal seized in Brooklyn last week end by Federal agents.

The agents had described the arsenal as a cache for the 17 Christian Front members and others charged with conspiring to overthrow the American Government.

The Eagle's informant, identified only as a high-ranking Army ordnance expert, said the new type of ammunition was manufactured exclusively for the Chemical Warfare Division of the Regular Army.

The Ordnance Division of the Army has launched its own investigation of the conspiracy, he said, because Federal Bureau of Investigation officers had not called upon the Army for assistance in their investigation.
