

**Jackson Widens
Sedition Probe**
Herald 4-1/2-40
**'Christian Front' Aides
Under Inquiry**

Attorney General Robert H. Jackson announced last night that "scope" of the grand jury investigation of sedition and other charges against 17 members of the "Christian Front" organization in New York would include examination of activities of others "working for similar unlawful ends."

The 17 were arrested by the Federal Bureau of Investigation last week end, charged with a plot against the Government.

"Out of this investigation," he added, "should come a clear identification of any persons or groups who have provoked or financed or otherwise conspired with these defendants."

Jackson said that he had transferred Assistant Attorney General O. John Rogge to New York from Louisiana, "in order to expedite the Brooklyn proceedings."
