Coughlin Still Mum on Why He Didn't Speak

**Broadcasting Station
'Has No Idea' of Cause
of His Silence**

DETROIT, Feb. 5 (UP).—Charles E. Coughlin remained secluded in his Shrine of the Little Flower today, declining to explain his unexpected failure to broadcast his regular Sunday sermon.

Catholic ecclesiastics likewise refused to comment except to suggest that church reviewers might have found some portion of the scheduled address unsuitable.

A spokesman at WJR, Coughlin's Detroit outlet, "had no idea" why, instead of an hour's sermon, the radio priest's period was devoted to organ and choir music interspersed with dramatic announcements advising listeners not to become alarmed and promising that Coughlin would return to the air next Sunday.
