"In fact, we are becoming more and more convinced that the radicals who have seized our Federal Government care not one whit about driving Hitler from the face of the earth." (*Social Justice*, Mar. 16, 1942).

And now, the man that devoted his full energies to the wider distribution of these seditious statements, is an officer.
