I. Amter, Communist candidate for President of the Bard of Aldermen, commenting on the exposure of Queens Bor ligh President George U. Harvey as an officer in an anti-Bem tic, fascist army now being organised with Republican aid, said toda; "The ranting red-batt r of Queens is running title to forn."

He stigmatized Harvey's alleged offer of borough-owned trucks to the new fascist army as "chitrely consistent with his never disproven membership in the Ku Klux Klansa similar if sillier fascist organization."

He pointed out that his offer was a concrete fledinition of the type of "Americalism" which Harvey had professed to be protecting when he forbade Communists the use of all public buildings in Queens. "Little Hitler Harvey," said Amter, "must be nearly sick with longing for greater power than he now possesses. This latest evidence of his resort to the dark forces of violence is clear proof of the final bankruptcy of the Republican Party, of which he is a member.
