**Amter Assails  
Harvey**

I. Amter, Communist candidate for President of the Board of Aldermen, commenting on the exposure of Queens Borough President George U. Harvey as an officer in an anti-Semitic, fascist army now being organized with Republican aid, said today:

"The ranting red-baiter of Queens is running true to form."

He stigmatized Harvey's alleged offer of borough-owned trucks to the new fascist army as "entirely consistent with his never disproven membership in the Ku Klux Klan, a similar, if sillier, fascist organization."

He pointed out that this offer was a concrete definition of the type of "Americanism" which Harvey had professed to be protecting when he forbade Communists the use of all public buildings in Queens. "Little Hitler Harvey," said Amter, "must be nearly sick with longing for greater power than he now possesses. This latest evidence of his resort to the dark forces of violence is clear proof of the final bankruptcy of the Republican Party, of which he is a member."
