War Veteran Assails Harvey and McNaboe

Jewish Convention Also Repts. Moseley

ROCHESTER, June 7.—George U. Harvey, Borough President of Queens, and State Senator John J. McNaboe today stood accused of encouraging "hate mongering and provocative preaching" because they spoke at meetings of the Christian Front, an anti-Semitic organization.

Archie Brick, chairman of Americanism committee of the Jewish War Veterans, denounced the two officials at that organization's annual convention here yesterday. He also assailed the Rev. Charles E. Coughlin, General George V. Moseley, and Fritz Kuhn of the German-American Bund for "anti-Semitic activities."

Other speakers referred to General Moseley as a "traitor who is spreading a spirit of hate and poison." A telegram protesting his "infamous slander" was sent to the Dies Committee.

John Michals was elected State commander, succeeding Sidney Z. Davidson of Roseton, New York. Charles E. Coughlin, senior vice commander, and Frank Lieberman, of Albany, junior vice commander. Mr. Michals named Mrs. Dorothy Greiner, New York City, as adjutant, and reappointed Mr. Brick.
