

Anti-Semitic Orator Denies Evading Draft

CHICAGO, June 15 (U.P.)—Joseph McWilliams, anti-semitic orator, pleaded innocent today to a charge of violating the selective service law, and said he would

enlist in the Army before his case comes up in court again. McWilliams, arrested Saturday for alleged failure to notify his draft board of a change of address, appeared at arraignment before U. S. Commissioner Edmund K. Walker. He had been held in custody since his arrest.
