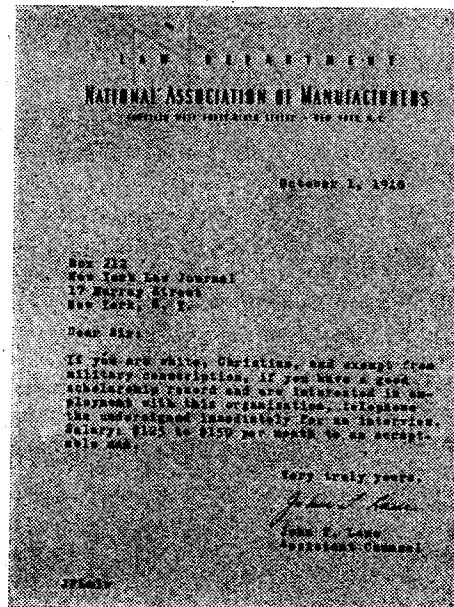


Some More Light On NAM and Jews

PM offers further evidence today of racial and religious discrimination in the law department of the National Association of Manufacturers, powerful organization of reactionary industrialists—some of whom are Jewish.

Last Thursday we printed a letter received by an honor graduate of Harvard Law School, a Jew, who had answered an NAM advertisement for a young lawyer. The letter specified "if you are a Gentile," and the specification later was repeated over the telephone.

Today we print a letter signed "John F.



Lane, assistant counsel," received by a Jewish boy who inserted an employment ad in the *Law Journal*. The writer suggests there may be a job at the NAM "if you are white, Christian, and exempt from military conscription."

The boy whose ad drew this reply is a last year's graduate of St. John's Law School. His ad read: "Attorney-clerk, experienced, desires additional experience and opportunity."
