

Dissolution of Reynolds Association Recommended

Dissolution of the Vindicators' Association, an organization incorporated in 1939 by Senator Reynolds, Democrat, of North Carolina and two others, was recommended in a report yesterday by District Court Auditor A. L. Sinclair.

The auditor's report revealed that Senator Reynolds testified before him that several objectives of the Vindicators have become outmoded and impracticable. Among its aims were to keep America out of war, abolish all "isms" except Americanism and fingerprint all aliens. Senator Reynolds in June first petitioned the court to dissolve the corporation on the grounds its ob-

jectives were no longer practicable. The association published a monthly magazine entitled The Vindicator. The auditor's report showed that assets consisted of \$200 in furniture in an office in the first block of Second street N.E. and \$156 in cash.
