FBI Arrests Pelley, Head of Silver Shirts

WASHINGTON, April 4.—Acting Attorney General Charles Fahy announced today that special FBI agents have arrested William Dudley Pelley, fuhrer of the pro-Nazi Silver Shirts, and charged him with carrying on propoganda designed to disrupt the Nation's war effort.

Pelley's arrest was seen as an indication that the Department of Justice is dropping its attitude of leniency toward pro-Nazi propagandists and is beginning to crack down on a wide front against fifth columnists.

The Silver Shirt leader's arrest marked the fifth case in which the Department of Justice has charged heads of pro-Nazi groups with impeding the war effort.
