Defendent Says Nucleus of 'Action Committee' Were Fronters

Michael J. Bierne, one of 14 men on trial in Brooklyn on charges of seditious conspiracy, testified yes-terday that the so-called "action committee" which allegedly plot-ted to overthrow the government consisted of a nucleus of "Chris-tian Front" members.

Testifying under cross-examination before a Federal Court jury, the witness said that John F. Cas-sidy had selected him among others to attend key meetings of the action group, then headed by William G. Bishop. Both Bishop and Cassidy are on trial. "Did this group consist of select-ed men from the Christian Front?" Assistant. United States Attorney

Assistant United States Attorney James D. Saver asked.

Bierne replied that the men all were members of the Front but were members of the Front but that he did not know if Cassidy had signaled them out. Saver then read from an earlier statement Bierne had made to the Federal Bureau of Investigation, in which the witness said that Cassidy se-lected nine men for Bishop's ac-tion committee. It was through tion committee. It was through that committee, the indictment charged, that the group hoped to foment disorders through anti-Semitic and other rioting and ther seize control of key governmen and public centers.
