

Plot Trial Jury Still Seeks Verdict

The jury considering a verdict on 14 men, some of them members of the Christian Front, on trial on conspiracy charges in Federal Court, Brooklyn, was still debating on its return from lunch this afternoon. They had been out then more than 10 hours.

Late in the morning, Mrs. Margaret McSweeney, 3410 Clarendon Rd., Brooklyn, said to be a friend of a defendant, fainted in court. She was given medical aid in the clinic in the Federal Building and sent home.

Judge Marcus B. Campbell, conducting the trial, excused the eleven men and one woman composing the jury for lunch without calling them to the courtroom. As they filed out of the building, the dozen seemed to be in good humor. Thirteen of the 14 on trial are accused of conspiracy to overthrow the government and to steal government property. The 14th is charged only with conspiracy to steal government property.
