

Christian Front Jury Given Day of Rest

NEW YORK, June 23 (C.T.P.S.). Deliberations of the Christian Front jury, which bid fair to become a permanent institution, were off temporarily today while the eleven men and one woman enjoyed a quiet Sabbath. Before ordering the jury locked up for the weekend in the Hotel St. George, Brooklyn, Federal Judge Marcus B. Campbell said there was to be a recess from deliberating. But the jurors tomorrow morning are to resume consideration of the fate of 14 persons accused of plotting to overthrow the Government.
