

Geneva, Switzerland (RNS) — New York offices of the World Council of Churches confirmed that the WCC has been sending limited aid to North Vietnam since 1965, primarily in the form of medical supplies and equipment.

In 1965, the World Council gave \$6,000 for medical supplies to the East Asia Christian Conference (EACC) for transport to North Vietnam through Red Cross.

In 1966, medical aid totaled \$10,000; it was given to the Polish Ecumenical Council, which arranged for articles to be purchased and shipped to the North through Polish Red Cross.

In 1967, the Asia Desk of the Division of Interchurch Aid, in cooperation with the International Committee of the Red Cross and Caritas Internationalis, bought \$40,000 worth of medical supplies and equipment for North Vietnamese civilians.

Although the total World Council aid channeled to North Vietnam in 1968 could not be immediately ascertained by the New York office, the appeal for both South and North Vietnam was \$500,000 — double that of the previous year's request.

Among some of the supplies channeled to the North by the World Council unit and other cooperating agencies were an \$80,000 mobile field hospital and \$18,000 in X-ray equipment.

In addition, WCC member Churches in Eastern Europe have sent aid through their own channels.

Winnipeg, Manitoba, Canada (RNS) – A New Democrat (Socialist) member of the Manitoba Legislature, Phillip Petursson, suggested here that the opening prayer of the House should be revised by a committee representing all faith groups. "Being a Unitarian," he said, "I feel perhaps it should begin, 'To whom it may concern.'

Vindication for Otto F. Otepka was achieved when President Richard M. Nixon, fulfilling a campaign pledge, appointed him to the Subversive Activities Control Board. Those who have closely followed the Otepka case painfully recall that this able and dedicated American was fired by former Secretary of State Dean Rusk from his position as chief of the evaluation section of the State Department's security office in November, 1963. He was dismissed, summarily, after he incurred the displeasure of Rusk and other high officials for telling a Senate Internal Security Subcommittee of laxity in checking security risks. Over a period of five years, he has been treated in a most shameful manner, suffering harassment and indignities.

Mr. Otepka agreed to accept the nomination to the Board after close friends in the Senate, including Strom Thurmond and Barry Goldwater, assured him that a White House nomination would erase all the charges previously leveled against him. Had he returned to the State Department, his position would have been practically untenable because of the hostile attitude still existing at Foggy Bottom. Nicholas Katzenbach, for example, has been retained by the Nixon Administration as a State Department security consultant.

The Subversive Activities Control Board has jurisdiction over all cases involving Communist organizations and individuals forwarded to it by the Attorney General for rulings. Under the Johnson Administration the SACB was given virtually no assignments because Ramsey Clark deliberately refused to forward cases to it. However, John Mitchell, President Nixon's Secretary of State, has given assurance that the Board will be a vigorous branch of the government. Observers note that Otepka's appointment could very well help the committee to become effective and meaningful.

All barriers are down! Purveyors of erotica in films, stage plays and literature may now go the limit. Supreme Court permissiveness has opened the floodgates of obscenity.

This is evidenced by what some call a landmark case. A motion picture film which was banned altogether in Norway and, for a time, in Belgium, censored in France and Germany and cut for showing in England is now being seen unexpurgated in two Manhattan theaters and scheduled for bookings across the country.

Previously, the U.S. Customs Office had sought to prevent the entry of the film into the United States, and a New York Federal Court jury found it obscene. However, confessing some unhappiness with its own decision, the U.S. Court of Appeals by a vote of two to one overruled the lower court and said the controversial film was not obscene and could be licensed for showings in this country. In effect, the court said, it was merely following the standards established by the Warren Supreme Court.

Writing in *The Wall Street Journal*, Alan M. Adelson, who apparently viewed the film, said "The 120 minutes of screening time depict the hero and heroine in abundant nudity, various scenes of intercourse (including one in the crook of a tree) and more exotic sexual play. It has a dream sequence in which the heroine castrates her lover." (Heretofore, U.S. films have treated nudity and homosexuality boldly, but thus far have left intercourse to the viewers' imagination.)

Interesting to note in all of this is the curious explanation

some make for the increase in sexual intimacies in films and literature. It is not, as one might suppose, the fault of the Supreme Court or the hard-core pornographers who are out to make a fast buck. The fault lies instead with those who cling stubbornly to Biblical morality.

Father John Culkin, who, according to Alan Adelson, is an ardent student of Marshall McLuhan and director of the Center for Communications at New York's Fordham University, sees the anti-censorship explosion as rooted in American puritanism.

"We're reaping a reaction to the very repressive atmosphere we've maintained in our families, churches and schools," Father Culkin is quoted as saying: "Calvin and those creeps left us very uptight. We weren't allowed to have bodies. And what we're going through now is a shakedown cruise exploring a new morality."

Such an explanation is typical, indeed, of the sophistry of modern sociologists, psychologists, "progressive" educators and leaders in the National Council of Churches who are as capable of inverting values as a magician is capable of slight-of-hand. They are, in our view, in the same class as those upon whom Isaiah pronounced judgment: "Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil; that put darkness for light, and light for darkness; that put bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter." (Isaiah 5:20)

However, as Adelson admits, some few Americans view the film as the final confirmation of disaster they have seen coming for some time. To them the rapid decline in morality approaches a state of total depravity, a judgment with which we could not agree more. We believe America is perilously close to a phallic society, which finds parallel in the history of ancient Canaan.

In their excavations of ancient Cannanite cities, archaeologists uncovered the "high places" or temples where the people worshiped their god, Baal, and their goddess, Ashtoreth. Under the rubbish in the high places, scientists found enormous quantities of images and plaques of Ashtoreth with rudely exaggerated sex organs, designed to stimulate eroticism. (What else were the images and plaques but the "films" and "literature" of that day.)

Temples of Baal and Ashtoreth were usually together. Priestesses were temple prostitutes. Sodomites were male temple prostitutes. The worship of Baal, Ashtoreth, Moloch and other Canaanite gods consisted of the most depraved sexual orgies. Under divine inspiration, Moses issued a stern warning to the people of Israel: "Thou shalt make no covenant with them [Canaanites], nor shew mercy unto them: Neither shalt thou make marriages with them; thy daughter thou shalt not give unto his son, nor his daughter shalt thou take unto thy son. For they will turn away thy son from following me, that they may serve other gods." (Deut. 7:2-4)

With the intrusion of sex education in the public schools, with enforcement of the law banning eighteen year olds from dirty movies left to the theater managers — which means little or no enforcement — we have concluded: Father Culkin and his ilk to the contrary, there is no question but that we are sacrificing our children to the gods of permissiveness. Sex is deified. The cult of erotica has established the "high places." The phallic society is almost here.








DAVID HITCHCOCK HEADS SPECIAL EVENTS UNIT

David L. Hitchcock was named head of the Special Events Department of Christian Crusade March 1, by Dr. Billy James Hargis, founder-director.

In this capacity, Mr. Hitchcock coordinates planning and preliminary arrangements and serves as corresponding secretary for Christian Crusade's national meetings and international tours and conclaves, including its general Convention, Preachers Convention, Teachers Convention, Leadership School, African, European and Asian Congresses.

He has been with Christian Crusade for three years, ably carrying out assignments in the Membership Department, Tour Department, Anti-Communist Youth University and Research Department.

Active as an anti-Communist in Indiana, he accepted the invitation to join the Christian Crusade team in Tulsa "because I feel anti-communism should be Christian oriented." He was responsible for developing the Christian Crusade Research Library, a project that required three months of diligent effort and, he said, gave him his greatest satisfaction.

Mr. Hitchcock received his education at Purdue University. He was a municipal employee of Anderson, Indiana, for one year, and office manager of a local finance company in Muncie for three years. For a time, he owned and managed his own retail bookstore in Anderson. He served on active duty in the U.S. armed forces, followed by six years in the active reserves of a local U.S. Army Chemical Corps unit.

He is a member of the Tulsa County Young Republicans. In 1968 he was honored as "Man of the Year" by Congressman Page Belcher for his work in the latter's re-election campaign. He is married to the former Judith Stubbs of Anderson. The couple has one son, Ronald.

CONSERVATIVE TEACHERS IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS

BY DR. BILLY JAMES HARGIS

Founder-Director, Christian Crusade

Communist conspirators are conducting an intensified campaign to get their speakers before American youth, especially on college campuses.

During the academic year of 1966 - 67, for example, 54 such appearances were made by leading Communist representatives at many universities, including DePaul, Minnesota, Texas, Illinois, Wisconsin, Nebraska, Notre Dame and Vanderbilt.

With this challenge before us, all-out effort must be made to solidify and train Conservative public schoolteachers. In a bold move, Christian Crusade has issued a call for the First National Convention of Conservative Teachers, Aug. 19 - 22, at The Summit, Manitou Springs, Colorado. See details on page 12.

On February 23, 1968, FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover submitted to the House Subcommittee on Appropriations a list of Communist speakers who had appeared on college campuses in 1966 - 67, and testified:

"The basic purpose behind the speaking campaign, which has been pursued with vigor since the early 1960s, is to gain recognition for and acceptance of the Communist Party, U.S.A., as a legitimate political party on the American scene. The Party considers that college campuses offer an excellent opportunity to reach the youth who will be the leaders of tomorrow."

In gaining access to many college campuses, Red conspirators have promoted the fraudulent idea that in order to learn about communism a person

must listen to a Communist. The exact opposite is true. One does not learn about communism by listening to a Communist because the Communists are cunning liars, and their speeches give a completely false image of communism.

One of the biggest lies promulgated by the Communists can be summed up in their much-used phrase, "the big lie of anti-communism." They claim that the facts about the vast Red conspiracy, which has enslaved millions and intends to enslave the entire earth, are nothing but a "big lie."

In their New Program of the Communist Party, U.S.A., published in February, 1966, the conspirators

expressed this as follows: "Malice and ignorance have cultivated the indecent suspicion that working class internationalism is a 'conspiracy.'..."

Such talk points up the need for informed and trained educators who can refute subtle Communist propaganda and neutralize Communist brainwashing of students and faculty.

Another big Communist lie with which Marxist speakers attempt to pollute young American minds is that anti-communism is the real danger to our nation. The 1966 New Program stated:

"The damage done American democracy by repressive anti-communism" is grave beyond measure... In presenting this program for public discussion, with its specific refutations of 'anti-Communist' myths and lunacies, we contribute to a democratic restoration..."

rom time to time, the Communists report on the efforts of their speakers who have invaded college campuses. One of the Red conspirators busiest speakers is Dr. Herbert Aptheker, Communist Party theoretician. The Worker of June 13, 1967, reported on his appearance at Notre Dame University.

"Nearly 400 students and nearby residents from South Bend heard Dr. Herbert Aptheker speak in the Law School Auditorium on the University of Notre Dame campus, applauding his prepared remarks on the topic, "The Relevance of Marxism in the United States Today."

"It was the first time a Communist

Party leader had spoken on campus. The South Bend Tribune, the only major newspaper in this area, which had buried the news of his coming in three short paragraphs on a back page, devoted an entire column to his address the following day."

Early in 1968, Aptheker again became the first Communist to appear on the campus of a Catholic university. This time it was the University of Dayton. He was invited by the student government and, according to *The Worker* of February 11, 1968, spent an entire day on the campus. *The Worker* stated:

"In the morning he discussed the origin of the cold war with a class of about 50 students in political science. This was followed with a lecture to 1,000 faculty members and students on 'U.S. Foreign Policy: A Marxian Critique.'

"Thereafter came television and press interviews and a dinner for Aptheker given by the university and attended by the vice president. This in turn was followed by an informal question period participated in by both faculty and students."

The June, 1968, issue of *Political Affairs*, official Communist monthly, printed the text of a speech by Gus Hall, general secretary of the C.P.U.S.A., at the University of Dakota [sic] on May 14, 1968. Hall told the college students that the cause of our nation's problems could be found "in the basic nature of capitalism as a system."

Hall said further: "... Social revolutions are not foreign imports... U.S. socialism will be molded by our experience as a nation, as a people... It will reflect our experiences with a multiple-party system. It will reflect our trade union experience. And when socialism comes onto the agenda, I am convinced that the majority of you in this hall tonight will not only be for it but will be advocating it — and helping to make it work."

Communist and Liberal elements have long recognized what Conservative forces have largely overlooked – namely, teacher power! That is the power and influence of teachers to mold the thinking and guide the actions of youth.

"Our major concern," wrote Dr. George S. Counts, noted "Progressive" educator, in a 1932 booklet Dare the

School Build a New Social Order?... "should be... to make certain that every Progressive school will use whatever power it may possess in opposing and checking the forces of social conservatism... Teachers, if they could increase sufficiently their stock of courage, intelligence, and vision, might become a social force of some magnitude... A society lacking leadership as ours does might even accept the guidance of teachers.

"Through powerful organizations they might at least reach the public conscience and come to exercise a larger measure of control over the schools than hitherto . . .

"That the teachers should deliberately reach for power and then make the most of their conquest is my firm conviction. To the extent that they are permitted to fashion the curriculum and the procedures of the school they will definitely and positively influence the social attitudes, ideals, and behavior of the coming generation . . . " (Italics ours) Almost thirty years ago, the Communists issued extensive directives regarding the objectives of Communist teachers and the strategy to be used in pursuing those objectives. These directives came in an article by Richard Frank, a member of the Education Commission of the Young Communist League, which appeared in the May, 1937, issue of the Communist magazine (later known as Political Affairs). Communist conspirators throughout our nation were advised:

"The task of the Communist Party must be, first and foremost, to arouse the teachers to class consciousness and to organize them into the American Federation of Teachers, which is the main current of the American labor movement. In the effort to organize the teachers, every care must be taken to bring together in united front actions all existing teacher organizations. (Italics ours)

"Especial attention must be paid to secure such action with the American Association of University Professors, the National Educational Association, and the Guild. Our Party members in these organizations must work actively toward this end."

This article described the responsibility of Communist teachers as

follows: "Communist teachers are, therefore, faced with a tremendous social responsibility... They must take advantage of their positions, without exposing themselves, to give their students, to the best of their ability, working-class education."

In this article, Richard Frank told teachers that "The problem is...to guide and direct that spirit of rebelliousness [among students against schools] which already exists..." He also said that they must undertake "serious education on immediate social problems." Of course, this was to be done from the Communist standpoint, which would be in a way that would undermine the foundations of freedom in our nation.

Columnist Holmes Alexander found a shocking situation on the campus of the University of Utah when he served as "writer-in-residence during Challenge Week" there. Mr. Alexander recounted his disturbing experiences in the Manchester (New Hampshire) Union Leader of March 12, 1966:

"...I behaved with the utmost decorum and had a wonderful time among students and faculty members, where I met some of the kindest and most charming people ever known to me. But the faux pas which I pulled innocently the first time, and mischievously thereafter, was of an enormity that set shock waves in motion. I praised patriotism. That's all—but it was plenty.

"I first noticed the hostility to patriotism when I remarked in a history class that American policy should be aimed at serving American self-interest and self-sufficiency. Several students thought me hopelessly narrow-minded in that remark. It was soon evident they had been taught to believe so broadly in world government and global responsibility that a primal concern for their own country was an unthinkable thought. For a few uncomfortable minutes, I felt myself being watched and questioned like a 'fascist beast.'"

Mr. Alexander reported on a last-day panel during Challenge Week which discussed "The Brave New World." During this panel, he suggested that, of all the "isms" mentioned during the week, the one most necessary to survival was patriotism. The result? "Well, you'd have thought I'd proposed mother-beating and baby-broiling. My co-panelists couldn't have behaved with more revulsion if Dr. Jekyll had writhed on the floor and turned into Mr. Hyde before their eyes." After describing the reaction of some of the visiting intellectuals, he concluded his article as follows:


"Each of the visiting intellectuals, you see, demeaned or ridiculed love-of-country at this large gathering of young Americans... Maybe they know what they're doing when they teach and preach this sort of nihilism to an oncoming generation. My own judgment is, however, that it's a dirty and dangerous trick to play upon other people's sons and daughters who will soon inherit the most humane and generous country on earth."

During a speech before the Union League of Philadelphia, a century-old business and professional men's club, on December 1, 1966, Senator Everett Dirksen (R-III.) commented that a "strange ferment and turbulence" among America's youth was threatening the nation. (The Tulsa Tribune, December 2, 1966)

In the course of following his statements and senatorial activities, we have seen little evidence that Senator Dirksen recognizes the Communist and pro-Communist influence which is at the roots of this "strange ferment and turbulence" among our nation's youth. However, FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover is well aware of it and consistently attempts to bring it to the attention of Americans. For example, in the February, 1967, issue of the FBI Law Enforcement Bulletin, he wrote:

"The great majority of college students are proud of their American heritage and loyal to the traditions of democracy. However, it is basic Communist strategy to further Communist objectives with non-Communist hands, and this is exactly what is happening on some college campuses. The idealism of many American students is being cynically exploited for Communist purposes; youthful exuberance is being channeled into unlawful riotous conduct; mocking disdain for democratic processes and moral values is being fed to inquisitive young minds - all under the guise of

seeking equal justice or some other noble cause.


"At the core of these campus disorders, and often below the surface, we find agitator personnel from organizations such as the Communist W.E.B. DuBois Clubs of America and their comrades in the Students for a Democratic Society...members of the Progressive Labor Party, a pro-Red Chinese group; and individuals associated with organizations under the control of the subversive Socialist Workers Party and similar groups..."



Two years ago, I went to The Summit for the first time. I didn't know anybody who was going. Nor did I know anybody who would be there. I didn't even know my Saviour then. I went completely alone. But I knew I would come back with a lot more than I had started with.

One of the next speakers was Harold Stassen. He was there to tell us how great the UN is. But I had learned some things about the UN at The Summit that were embarrassing to Stassen — and I asked questions.

Another speaker was the famed economist, Kenneth Boulding. His contention was that the only way out of the mess we are in is through Fabian socialism. He assured us that, although they appear to be similar, Fabian socialism and communism are not anything alike. But I had learned about these Marxian blood-brothers at The Summit — and so I asked, "If Fabianism and communism are so dissimilar, how come the famous Fabian, George Bernard Shaw, called Lenin 'the greatest Fabian of them all?"

My Summit education has also been very helpful to me on assignments.

In summer school, we had to do an extended definition for English. Of the topics in the book, my teacher cautioned us against defining a political system because it appeared to be impossible — especially communism. Stubborn as I am, I proceeded to define communism. He was amazed! He requested a copy for a pen-pal in Belgium who was being taken in by Communist ideology.

How was it possible to define

communism? Simple. At The Summit we learned to define communism simply and clearly. We learned that communism is a world view and can be broken into several facets:

Religiously, it is atheism.

Philosophically, dialectical materialism.

Economically, socialism.

Politically, tyranny or dictatorship.

Ethically, class morality.

Psychologically, Pavlovianism.

Biologically, Lysenkoism.

From there, all I had to do was quote Communist leaders to substantiate the statements and further explain each facet.

This fall I look forward to writing a paper for a course on the Old Testament, using knowledge from The Summit to explode modernist contentions.

These are all examples of individual efforts. And I realized that individual efforts alone could not begin to win this battle—I knew that I must either join with an organization already established or start an organization to work on our campus to minimize the effects of the New Left and maximize those of conservatism.

In this effort, I have extended myself in several directions.

First, I joined Young Americans for Freedom. I presently am secretary and assemblyman for the group. In our work, we have been able to help defeat members of SDS and their fellow travelers who ran for positions in student government last spring. At one point we had to be prepared to film a campus disturbance in order to detect what persons were responsible. We also have investigated drug use on the campus.

I also joined Young Republicans, to which I am directing most of my efforts presently as newsletter editor and secretary. I have had the opportunities to attend the State YR Convention, leadership training schools, and to work for NBC on election coverage through YR's.

At Whitewater we are building a club that already ranks as one of the top clubs — and probably one of the most Conservative — in the state. Our goal is to build a Conservative state federation which will result in a more Conservative voting public in 1972 — when we will be able to vote.

My experience with YR's has been of great educational value, and, were I to suggest a course for Summit graduates, I would recommend first that they find a good Christian church and, second, that they get into Young Republicans — or Young Democrats — and see how things work.

Besides working with established groups, I have also helped in organizing a group called University Plus. Our motto is "Better student government through greater student awareness," and our job is to inform the student body and stimulate their interest in student government. This group is serving as a link between the students and administration. We also serve at the pleasure of the president as an investigating committee. University Plus was conceived on our campus and now is being organized on campuses around the state.

My involvements in these organizations and my leadership capacities in them are, in a large part, the result of my schooling at The Summit.

My story is only one of hundreds of Summit graduates. It is a story repeated all over the nation every year because people support The Summit.

"... Getting Out of Hand."

Dear Friend:

FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover announced recently he is worried about the Communist-inspired and directed "youth revolution" in America ... it may well be getting out of hand.

As parents, we are worried about the powerful, bizarre, evil influences at work among our young people today. And this concern is doubly felt by Christian and Conservative young people who are trying to live for Christ and uphold concepts of freedom in this evil day.

Not satisfied with their phenomenal recruitment of college-and-university-age youth, the Reds and their left-wing atheistic, Liberal allies are now heading for the high school campus.

On March 25, according to an Associated Press release, "A 'hip' preacher ... says the NEXT WAVE of youthful protest is going to come in the high schools, in coalitions of blacks and whites and among alienated white middle-class students.

"'It's really in the air now, it's really there,' says the Reverend Larry Beggs. 'The whole thing has slipped down a notch,' Beggs says, 'from the protest that began in the colleges and continues to sweep the country.'"

As Christian Crusade was the first organization to prove that the Communists had a master music plan to use rock-and-roll and folk music to recruit youth to immorality and unpatriotic action, it now gives us some pleasure to see the national news media, at long last, becoming rightly concerned about this evil influence.

In Time magazine of February 28, the editors reported on the immorality of teen-agers who religiously follow these wild and Red rock-and-folk groups.

The rock-and-roll groups now look with contempt upon the gullible teen-agers who follow them, especially the girls who willingly sacrifice their morals to their beatnik heroes. Calling them "groupies," Frank Zappa, leader of the Mothers of Invention, a well-known rock group, defines these "girl groupies" as "girls who go to bed with members of rock-and-roll bands."

In the same issue of Time, Harlan Ellison, a California free-lance writer, recalls a harrowing night in San Diego "three years ago when he was touring with the Rolling Stones."

"Spotting a young groupie crawling along the ledge outside his second-floor hotel room, he opened a sliding glass door to let her in, but she slipped, fell into the ocean -- breaking her wrist -- and had to be fished out by the Coast Guard.

"Ellison had barely recovered from that fright when another girl walked through his door and asked him if he was a friend of the Stones. When he said yes, she stripped and flopped onto his bed."

In March, a rock group called The Doors performed in Miami, Florida, before 12,000 kids (largely twelve to four-teen-year-olds who had paid a \$6 admission fee). During the lurid "performance," a twenty-four-year old singer named Jim Morrison exposed himself and proceeded to masturbate on stage.

Starring youthful actors, a stage play titled "Che" recently opened in New York City. It featured acts of sexual intercourse and oral copulation on the stage in front of the audience consisting largely of college-age youth.

What are we going to do about this "youthful revolution" that is both communistic and evil to the core? God knows, we had better worry about it and do something quickly!

Nothing angers me more than to hear adults complain about this awful mess, and yet do nothing about it. Fortunately, there is something we can do. For one thing, we can encourage and further motivate the teen-agers across the land who have not "bowed the knee to Baal," but who are willing to live for God and country.

EXPETIMENTS ** in the Bizarre ***


In Portland, Oregon, fifty school administrators recently took part in a sensitivity training session conducted by a University of Portland psychologist. John Guernsey, education writer for the Portland Oregonian, witnessed the scene.

Not wishing to go all out, he wrote, the school officials, both men and women, just removed their shoes. Some thought it was an "excellent experience"; others thought they were being called upon "to act like a bunch of nuts" when there was more important business at hand. One school supervisor flunked the sessions because he did not take his mission seriously enough; he led a woman, whose eyes were closed, into the men's restroom.

In another exercise, the school administrators formed a circle and then took turns standing in the center, letting themselves fall backward. Some in the circle weren't paying close enough attention, and one participant landed on the floor. "He is now driving himself mad trying to figure out why his 'friends' don't like him," Guernsey reported.

The session also called for the participants to close their eyes, wander about the room in bare feet with arms outstretched, and "try to identify" when their hands touched someone. No major damage resulted from the "wander-around-feel-and-relate" sessions, the *Oregonian* writer said, "but one educator is now known as a blindfold-and-clutch specialist."

An increasing number of college students engage in sensitivity sessions. And, according to Mr. Guernsey, "some

of them with a bit more than their shoes off. Some are even known to sit in circles for hours saying nothing, but rubbing shoulders all the while. Maybe this is the follow-up to the Eskimoes and the nose-rubbing communication they have been performing for years."

While using satire to describe what he saw and heard, John Guernsey was not taken in. He is perceptive. I gathered this from a lengthy conversation I had with him several months ago. He sees sensitivity training for what it is — a pseudo-science.

However, it's something that can't be laughed off. After considerable study, I am convinced the practices and goals of sensitivity training have a sinister aspect, and this is coming more and more to light.

Sensitivity training, of course, hides behind many names, depending on the mood of the intellectuals who push it and the type of audience picked for a target.

For example, in the Communist police states, it is openly known as self-criticism. This self-criticism is followed by mutual criticism of each other, always in a group setting. It gained momentum during the Russian Revolution. Included among the Party slogans of 1929 was "Through Bolshevistic self-criticism, we will enforce the dictatorship of the proletariat."

Briefly, it operates as follows: The entire population is divided into small groups of ten to twenty persons. Called collectives, they meet regularly on a permanent and required basis. No member can have a private life with the group constantly and critically watching him.

Members sit in a circle with no table or other furniture to interfere with the confessionals that take place. Each person takes his turn criticizing himself, telling of his faults and shortcomings no matter how trivial; then each person is encouraged to tell exactly how he feels about the other members of the collective and then each criticizes the other.

Obviously, the object is to locate faultfinders and troublemakers and to uncover any dangerous original thinkers or possible future agitators. The procedure, of course, develops an atmosphere of distrust and fear among the people as they become isolated from each other.

In Russia, the results of this controlled system are well-known through the arrests and disappearances of prominent persons after a frank, self-criticism session.

During the Korean War, American prisoners were brainwashed with the same method, and the constant group criticism resulted in three out of every four men turning informers. This prevented any escapes since escape takes teamwork, and the men who psychologically tore each other apart in the group sessions learned only to hate and distrust one another.

In America, the National Education Association has played a major role in the development of self-criticism or what is popularly called, in academic circles, sensitivity training.

In 1946, Dr. Leland Bradford, an executive of the National Education Association, and a number of social psychologists worked with pioneer behavioral scientist, Kurt Lewin, in researching how changes could be made in man's behavior. A somewhat milder and less direct method than the Communists' self-criticism was developed – sensitivity training.

Dr. Bradford and his associates decided to open shop in a large, rambling Victorian estate in Bethel, Maine. This later became the National Training Laboratories Institute for Applied Behavioral Science, an affiliate of the National Education Association.

Since 1954, the National Training Laboratories has worked with the American Red Cross, Puerto Rican government workers, public school teachers and administrators, since 1960 with such groups as the Protestant Episcopal Church of the United States, the Methodist Church, Esso Corporation and Union Carbide — to mention a few.

A program for training sensitivity trainers was developed with the support of the Foreign Operations Administration of the United States government. The result was a team of 26 social scientists and educators from seven Western European nations skilled in sensitivity techniques. The National Training Laboratories, called NTL for short, has also held sessions for industrial managers in a number of Western European countries and has trained teams from Austria and the Netherlands. New

spawning beds for sensitivity training are the various NTL-sponsored laboratories in the United States, such as the Western Training Laboratory in Texas, and the Institute of Industrial Relations at the University of California, Los Angeles.

Sensitivity training is doubtless well on its way. It has been braved by many, but its critics are growing since most people try to adhere to decent moral values and cherish a degree of privacy. Sensitivity training, on the other hand, encourages its trainees to abandon their traditional values and personal privacy.

The sensitivity training program at the National Training Laboratories in Bethel, Maine, usually runs for two weeks. Each group is a cultural island, removed from the usual stress of work and family life. Here now is a typical procedure.

As the members arrive, they are divided into several groups under the leadership of a professional trainer. The trainers decide how the groups will be managed, how they will communicate, what role-playing will take place and what theory sessions will be given.

The procedure itself appears deceptively simple. Men and women are brought together without any previous clues as to their identity or experiences. Seated in a circle, the trainer explains he will provide neither rules nor instructions. The group must decide.

Once the members realize the trainer is apparently not going to help them, they usually go through an "unfreezing" period during which they become acquainted with each other. Slowly, the personal relationships within the group grow and sometimes become so intense that fierce antagonisms develop.

These groups are a world unto themselves, and the members are the only citizens. Time and events in the outside world are forgotten. Only the group is

important, and it can be a benevolent, warm haven or a cage filled with snarling, snapping wolves who all direct their criticism toward one member or toward each other until they break down all hidden thoughts of feeling within the group.

Sensitivity training can and does take a bizarre direction. For example, there are nude marathons lasting 24 to 48 hours being staged in California under the direction of psychotherapist, Paul Bindrim.

Bindrim maintains, "Man's clothes are both a safeguard for his privacy and a self-imposed constraint to keep out people whom he fears." He concludes that if man disrobes physically, he might be better able to disrobe emotionally.

Strange as it may seem, this view is supported by Dr. Abraham Maslow, President of the American Psychological Association. He sees these marathons as a kind of psychological nudism where physical nudity is added so that members can go away more spontaneous and less guarded and defensive "not only by the shape of their behinds but freer and more innocent about their minds as well."

Bindrims' first experimental group consisted of 20 persons already involved in group therapy. Some were single, some married and some about to be married. Their problems included sexual difficulties which Psychologist Bindrim believes were the result of "Puritan teachings that nudity is shameful."

The nude marathon was held at an isolated nudist camp complete with a heated whirlpool bath. As each member arrived for the session, he was asked how he felt about the session in which he would soon join in the nude. Many were put at ease by just talking about it. And, most of the group, according to Bindrim, readily became quite comfortably nude after looking at each other in what he

called sensory saturation with peak stimuli. This, of course, in unclinical terms is nothing more than visual lust.

There were many interesting activities for the group to perform. For instance, members picked a friendly partner of the opposite sex, and they looked at each other as long as they comfortably could. They closed their eyes and touched and smelled favorite objects, such as roses or velvet. Then they sat in a circle and shared their experiences. This, supposedly, freed them of repressions and helped solve their problems. Bindrim's nude sensitivity marathons are now being held in a desert motel near Palm Springs, California, and I understand he has a waiting list.

Another experimental session was held recently by the University of Portland Professor, Dr. William Banaka. The group members got on their knees, and with eyes shut, explored the floor with both hands. One of them commented: "I never realized what a chair feels like with your eyes closed." Technically, this is labeled space exploration.

They also danced with complete a bandon, and in another exercise, confidence and trust in their fellow human beings were supposedly developed by leaning back and helping each other up without touching the floor with their hands, and by leading each other around with their eyes closed.

The theory here is that by learning to trust each other physically, they will become emotionally trusting and will then shed their inhibitions. This approach is highly developed at the Eslin Institute in California where all kinds of gymnastic experiences are being tested.

Sensitivity training is no longer an obscure psychological procedure. It is "catching on" and represents an insidious methodology which aims to destroy historical Christianity and traditional Americanism.

MY RED NIGHTMARE

he other night I had a dream:

U.S. Naval Intelligence Ship was captured on the high seas by the North Koreans. Because this was an act of war, many wanted to use force to obtain its release. However, certain officials in Washington warned that military action might provoke World War III and decided to negotiate instead.

The following week Communist Cuba invaded Florida. Many people wanted to use force to drive out the invaders. However, certain officials said any attack on the Cubans might provoke World War III. The Soviet Union warned that it would not sit idly by and watch Cubans shot down by American imperialists. Three days later Florida fell to the Cubans. Senator William J. Fulbright of Arkansas said it didn't matter anyway, we still had 49 states left.

Two days afterward, members of the SDS poisoned the water supply of New York City, killing two million people, in order to dramatize their opposition to the rottenness of our society. The Justice Department, fearing arrests might provoke riots, decided to adopt a wait-and-see attitude. An SDS leader, appearing on Meet The Press the following week, said that while he deplored mass murder, he could understand the frustrations of those who had done this.

The next morning Cuban troops from Florida invaded the state of Georgia. The Georgia National Guard held the invaders to a stalemate. Certain senators said the only way to solve the conflict was to have a coalition government in Georgia. Advised that anything was better than World War III, the American people agreed.

Three days later five Russian submarines sailed up the Charles River, depositing troops and supplies on the Harvard campus. The American people demanded their immediate expulsion, but authorities at Harvard pointed to their policy of academic freedom. Militant student groups gave them sanctuary.


The Soviet Union said any interference with their craft would bring dire consequences. The American people, warned again by their leaders of the possibility of World War III, decided against any action.

Senators Jacob Javits of New York and Fulbright, when asked for comment, said they would have to study the matter more fully. Senator Eugene McCarthy of Minnesota said most of the current confusion was the fault of right-wing Americans who insisted on following the age-old myth that world communism was trying to take over the world.

The following week swarms of Black Militants, carrying pictures and placards

of Che Guevara, occupied government buildings in Washington and refused to give them up until their demands were met. The Congress, now meeting in a local movie theater, debated what to do.

Four days later the Soviet Union invaded Alaska. Some Americans said that in retaliation we should bomb Russia. But an influential group of high government officials said this might cause the death of some civilians and therefore be immoral. The churches opposed any bombings and other "aggressive" actions. Nothing was done; nobody wanted World War III.

Three weeks later the United States fell to the Communist powers. The American people, now living in concentration camps, decided to elect representatives to the occupational government in Washington. They chose certain Liberal senators and other peace-at-any-price spokesmen as their delegates. And why not? Hadn't their leadership prevented World War III?



CRUSADE HOSTS SEMINAR ON VIETNAM AND ASIA

World anti-Communist leaders from Korea and the Philippines were featured in a "Seminar on Vietnam and Asia" in March at the Cathedral of the Christian Crusade, Tulsa.

Admiral Sohn Won II of Korea and Dr. Jose Ma. Hernandez of Manila, P.I., took part in the three-day meet, March 21 - 23.

Two outstanding spiritual leaders from Korea also participated. They were Dr. Nam Chin Cha, Dean of Students at Korea Presbyterian Theological Seminary, Seoul, and Dr. Yang Sool Dow, Presbyterian pastor and professor at the Seminary.

Seminar leaders also included Major General Edwin A. Walker (Resigned), Dallas, Texas, Brig. General Richard B. Moran (Retired), Kerrville, Texas, and Dr. Billy James Hargis, founder-director of Christian Crusade.

Dr. Hargis explained why he had planned the Seminar. "My patience is exhausted at the unceasing attacks on our involvement in Vietnam by Liberal preachers, educators and politicians. Therefore, I felt compelled to invite these authorities on communism to the United States and give them an opportunity to explain the position of our American GIs and their Vietnamese allies in this struggle against communism in the Far East."

Dr. Hernandez, who gave the keynote address at the first session, is president of Victoria College, Manila, and secretary-general of the World Anti-Communist League. He has been an educator, soldier and statesman, including service as a major in the U.S. Armed Forces Far East during World War II. He is a graduate of Notre Dame University. Two of his children are U.S. citizens and live in this country.

Admiral Sohn served as chief of naval operations for the ROK Navy in 1948, as minister of defense in 1953, and as Korean ambassador to West Germany from 1957 to 1960.

Except for one major address, the Seminar consisted of panel discussions on vital topics, which included: "Korea after Panmunjom"; "The Pueblo and the Vietnam War – Why American Involvement?"; "The Vietnam War and Paris Peace Talks."

uestioned about the Pueblo, Admiral Sohn replied: "We understood the Pueblo carried the most modern U.S. equipment and all the captured equipment went to Moscow. We think, of course, this was one reason for her capture, but we also believe the Pueblo incident was in part an effort to get the United States to retaliate so the North Koreans would have an excuse to strike at South Korea."

The capture of the Pueblo, Admiral Sohn continued, occurred just two days after 31 commandos from North Korea had penetrated ROK defenses. "They had only one avowed mission," he said, "to kill President Park and those in the Blue House, our equivalent to your White House. The North Koreans have openly declared they intend to 'unify Korea' in the seventies.

"The Korean Armistice Agreement was signed in 1953, and since then, the people of the Republic of Korea have, tried to live a peaceful, productive and happy life. But we have not been allowed to live in peace and carve our own destiny. The Armistice Agreement has been violated 6,000 times by Communists under Kim Il Sung of North Korea in the last 15 years.

"We know they mean to take our territory and make of Korea a Communist nation. They are becoming increasingly aggressive, training factory workers and all women over the age of seventeen as troops. They have about 26,000 special troops and are repeatedly invading our demilitarized zone. Our defense department has pleaded for permission to send retaliatory troops into North Korea, but the U.S. Military Officer has said no."

According to Dr. Hernandez, the forces of freedom are inhibited in the fight against communism because the American mind has been conditioned by propaganda to believe if the United States does this or that it will mean the beginning of a third world war. Leaders in Southeast Asia, he said, are convinced the "domino theory" is correct. "Our World Anti-Communist League conferees are sponsored by their governments (48 nations are represented), so that we have

authoritative people in attendance. Our conclusion is that if South Vietnam falls, the whole of Southeast Asia, from Australia to the Philippines, will follow. But we also believe that the Communist armies are effective only when they are on the offensive. Otherwise, they turn tail and run."

Dr. Hernandez said Burma is almost completely Communist, Pakistan is in trouble and the Philippines and Thailand are under threat. "We believe that without massive support from the United States, Vietnam would be overrun by the Viet Cong."

In his view, the Paris peace talks are a repetition of Panmunjom. "The so-called peace talks at Panmunjom resulted in the longest 'armistice' in the world's history. Such an armistice is all that can be expected from the Paris talks, and it will be one with all advantages to the Communists and none to the Free World."

On the bombing halt of North Vietnam, Dr. Hernandez stated his belief that it was ordered by President Johnson as a purely political maneuver to aid

former Vice President Hubert Humphrey's campaign.

"When the bombing halt was called last November," he said, "the United States requested reciprocal de-escalation by the North Vietnamese and Viet Cong, and hopeful people everywhere expected a reduction of military action. Instead, the North Vietnamese and Viet Cong seized the opportunity to bring up more arms, materiel and ammunition - including recognizable Russian tanks, typifying the Communist disdain of 'co-existence' or cooperation."

Together with their guest panelists from Asia, General Moran and General Walker contributed authoritatively to the interesting and informative discussions. Dr. Hargis served as moderator. General

Walker commanded infantry and artillery units during the Korean War, and he and his men set a record for the most number of artillery rounds fired per hour during the fighting on Heartbreak Ridge.

THE PRINCIPLE OF THE FAITH PROMISE

THE AMAZING STORY OF DR. OSWALD J. SMITH - PASTOR, AUTHOR, HYMN WRITER AND MISSIONARY STATESMAN.

Dr. Oswald Smith was for 35 years pastor of the People's Church in Toronto. This church gives about a quarter of a million dollars each year to Christian missions.

Dr. Smith says it doesn't require any faith to give a cash offering. "If I have a dollar in my pocket, all I have to do is tell my hand to go into my pocket, find the dollar, take it out, and put it on the plate. I don't have to trust Him for any amount. I just have to give it."

But a faith promise is different. God first led Dr. Smith into this kind of giving when, as a young pastor, he was taking part in a missionary convention in his church. The ushers were giving out faith promise envelopes, and one of them gave an envelope to the pastor. Dr. Smith knew nothing about this idea. But he

bowed his head, closed his eyes, and prayed:

"Lord I can't take part in this offering. The church is paying me only \$25 a week. I have a wife and family to support: the war is on; prices are sky high. I do not have two cents to rub together at the end of the week. I have nothing in the bank; I have nothing in my pocket. Therefore it is quite evident that I cannot participate in this offering in any way whatsoever."

Then God began to speak to him. "I am not asking for what you have."

"Then what are you asking, Lord?"

"I am asking for a faith offering. How much can you trust Me for?"

"Well Lord," Dr. Smith said, "that's different. How much can I trust Thee for? I have never in my life given that kind of an offering. I have only given an offering when I have had it. I have never given an offering when I did not have it. How much can I trust Thee for?"

Dr. Smith says he thought God might ask him for five dollars. Then he got a little nervous. God might possibly say ten dollars. Only once in his life had Mr. Smith given five dollars to missions, but never more than that. He prayed, "Lord, how much? You will have to tell me."

Just as clearly as if it had been an audible voice came the reply, "Fifty dollars."

Dr. Smith was ready to argue with the Lord. "Why, Lord, that is two weeks' salary! How could anyone ever give two weeks' salary?"

But God never changed the amount. Again He said, "Fifty dollars."

With more fear than faith, Dr. Smith wrote \$50 on the pledge envelope and handed it to one of the ushers.

WOULD YOU LET THEM DIE?

President Richard M. Nixon is being asked to use the powers of his office to intercede on behalf of persecuted Christians behind the Iron Curtain.

The request comes to him in the form of petitions, circulated in mass quantities by Christian Crusade, and signed by compassionate Americans concerned about Christian believers in Communist countries who are being arrested, imprisoned and tortured for their faith in Christ.

The above heading — "WOULD YOU LET THEM DIE?" — is taken from the petition itself. Scripture text used is Matthew 25:35,36, "I was in prison, and ye came unto me."

Addressed to the President and Congress of the United States, the petition reads: "We, the undersigned citizens of the United States of America, are very deeply concerned at the recent increase of vicious attacks against the Church and the intensification of religious persecution in Soviet Russia — the arrest and murder of the Russian believers in prison. We respectfully urge your intercession in behalf of the suffering Russian Christians and all other religious believers. . . . To bring the attention of the United Nations Organization to the violation of basic human rights by the USSR."

Below the petition text are 33 spaces for the signatures of those who endorse this statement and, in effect, plead with the President to do what he can to help the suffering saints.

An example of what is taking place in Russia comes to our attention from a translation of Soviet government publications by Paul Voronaeff, Russian-born evangelist and author.

Here is a report from the government

newspaper Sovietskaya Byelorussiya of August 15, 1967:

"Pastor F. Kopenkov, in his sermons, urged his fellow believers, whose minds were saturated with religious deception. to educate their children in religion; to invite members of their families and friends to join the church. Because of these illegal activities, Pastor F. Kopenkov was fined. This resentful fanatic then organized public protest of believers. They sang Psalms. Then the pastor urged the parents to infect their children with religion and to draw them away from the influence of the schools. This was to prepare them to join the church. For this flagrant violation of the laws, Pastor F. Kopenkov was imprisoned."

This is what the Communists call "religious freedom," and these are the people in whose behalf we are asking the

Every month after that he had to get be alone with God and ask Him to send four dollars. Every month God sent it in. The pastor could not take it out of his salary — he wasn't getting enough. How God sent it, he doesn't know to this day. But at the end of the year he had paid in every cent of the \$50 he had promised.

He was so thrilled with what the Lord did that he doubled his pledge the next year. And the following year he doubled it again. Then the church raised his salary.

Dr. Smith testifies: "You can't beat God giving. The more you give the more God gives. Why, as soon as the church raised my salary, I had received more than the entire amount I had given. There came a day when I was able to double my pledge again. Later I doubled it once more." It was all working so wonderfully that he was giving \$800 a year by then.

He says, "And then there came a day when I was able to double it again and make it \$1,600. And now for 35 years I have been laying up thousands upon thousands of dollars in the bank of heaven. If I had waited until I had the cash, I would not have given it at all. I gave it when I did not have it. I gave it when I had to trust God for it."


