Of the 35 U.S. Senate elections to be held this year, there are 5 or 6 races where the conservative Republicans have an exceptionally good chance to defeat the incumbent liberal Democrats.

I'm sure you've heard before how important early money is.


But believe us we know because we might not be in the U.S. Senate today if our campaigns had not received that vitally important early money.


Altogether they need about \$47,000 early money. This is money that is needed in the next few weeks. We would like to be able to put you down as a member of the "early money team."
