A.Y.C. representatives deny previous charges of Communist domination.

Jack McMichael said it took 15 months, during which they constantly sought an opportunity to appear before the Dies committee before representatives of his organization were given an opportunity to testify and that it was just 15 hours ago that the Youth Congress was granted permission.

McMichael said also, "The Dies committee made up its mind about the Youth Congress in January, 1959, without having heard any of the facts. In reporting to Congress at that time the included slanderous statements about the Youth Congress * * * without the testimony of a single officer."

Mrs. Roosevelt commented that she had heard "nothing new at the hearing" which she attended.
