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WASHINGTON, Dec. 1.—There was a significant bit of by-play Tuesday when the British Ambassador deposited a copy of the Magna Charta at the Library of Congress. In accepting oustodianship of this document, Archibald MacLeish, the librarian of Congress, made a statement deliberately addressed to the Dies committee on "un-American activities."
