Barton Cals Dies Inquiry
'Unjudicial Demagogic'

But the Will Vote for \$21,000 to Connue It

Representative Buce Barton, speaking last night at the Metropolis Club, 105 Wet Fifty-seventh Street, criticized the Dies Committee Investigating Un-American Activities as sometimes "unjudicial and demagogic," but added that he would vote at the next session of Congress for an additional \$20,000 to continue its activities. He said, though, that the committee which is headed by Represent tive Martin Dies, Democrat, of Tales, would have to give a good case for itself.

Mr. Barton said that one of the safeguards "of our democracy is the third-term tradition," and that a third term was definitely a septoward one-man run and Fascism. "I would not have weed for Washington or Jefferson or a third term, he added.

About 200 members of the club attended the dilner at which Mr. Barton spoke. I. N. Kleinbaum, president of the club, presided.
