

Barton Calls Dies Inquiry 'Unjudicial Demagogic'

But Says He Will Vote for
\$25,000 to Continue It

Representative Bruce Barton, speaking last night at the Metropolis Club, 105 West Fifty-seventh Street, criticized the Dies Committee Investigating Un-American Activities as sometimes "unjudicial and demagogic," but added that he would vote at the next session of Congress for an additional \$25,000 to continue its activities. He said, though, that the committee, which is headed by Representative Martin Dies, Democrat, of Texas, would have to give a good case for itself.

Mr. Barton said that one of the safeguards "of our democracy is the three-term tradition," and that a third term was definitely a step toward one-man rule and Fascism. "I would not have voted for Washington or Jefferson for a third term," he added.

About 200 members of the club attended the dinner at which Mr. Barton spoke. E. N. Kleinbaum, president of the club, presided.
