# Former Red Conspirator Who Fled U. S. Paroled

RALEIGH, N. C., Jan. 8. (U.P.)—released at 11 a.m. tomorrow. Beal Fred Ewin Beal, 45-year-old former Communist labor organizer, who fled to Russia to escape serving a 17 to 20 year sentence for murder conspiracy and later returned to give himself up, was paroled today by Gov. J. M. Broughton after serving three years and 11 months.

Beal forfeited his \$5,000 bond soon after his conviction and fled to the Soviet Union where he remained seven years. Then he denounced Communism and returned to serve his sentence.

Broughton signed the parole papers late today and Beal will be
