Brodie, Reid, president, National Deposit Bank, Owensboro, Ky. May 18, 1939, afternoon session; Volume 5, pp. 3221-3223; (executive session)

3221- Didn't know J. E. Campbell until "last month".

Investigator asked him if he knew a James E. Campbell. He didn't, had no record knew of him, and called other sources. None of the other banks in twon/or knew of Campbell.

Discovered from Credit Bureau that Campbell had an office in the odd Fellows Building.

Called Campbell's office and was told by woman, "Mr. Campbell is not in."

Found out that Campbell had an account in Citizens Deposit Bank in Calhoun, 18

miles away.

(Note: This witnesses' testimony could have been adequately adduced by an affidavit with no less effect and a considerable saving.
