After a morning of "private interrogation" Dies said,
"We have seized more documents than we expected; they include membership lists including those of the Communists, but the Bund in Chicago
has destroyed its records and the Silver Shirts claim they don't
keep records." Dies went on to say, "The extent of the Red and Maxi
espionege system in Chicago is amazing" and that the leaders of
"purely aliem groups " * * frankly admit their link with foreign
powers. They are active and revolutionary. I will have important
revelations to make shortly and there will be presecutions to discuss
with United States Atterney, W.J. Campbell."

The story concludes with the statement attributed to Dies that Chicago is the nerve center of a west espionage system.
