Speaking before the Chicago chapter of the D.A.R. in the Stern Hotel last night John C. Metcalfe, Dies' personal aide, said much of Dies' hearing will be devoted to "alleged red" activities in the steel, farm, implement, and packing industries.

The union connected the investigation by Dies as an attempt to smear it prior to the election scheduled for four days later.
