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APPROPRIATION FOR DIES COMMITTEE

Mr. COCHRAN. Mr. Speaker, many Members of the House have called me and asked when the resolution appropriating money for the Dies Committee to Investigate Un-American Activities will be called up. The Committee on Accounts ordered me yesterday to report a resolution appropriating \$110,000 for the expenses of that committee, which includes the deficit; this to carry on its activities up to January 3 next.

It was my purpose to call the resolution up today, but in view of the agreement made by the majority leader that no controversial legislation would be called up for the remainder of this week, may I say now that if the Speaker will recognize me on Tuesday next, I will call the resolution up then.

Mr. RICH. Will the gentleman yield?

Mr. COCHRAN. I yield to the gentleman from Pennsylvania.

Mr. RICH. Is this a controversial measure?

Mr. COCHRAN. I do not know. That remains to be seen. If the gentleman had heard the Members of Congress, some of whom voted for the extension of that committee, oppose the appropriation, I think he would say it was controversial.
