**Immigrants and  
unemployment**

"In recent years the total number of aliens admitted to the United States exceeds the number of our unemployed."—Representative Martin Dies, in *Liberty*.

The number of unemployed is estimated at nine to twelve million.

Immigrants in the four-year period 1935-38 numbered 189,424.

In the ten-year period ending June 30, 1939, immigrants exceeded emigrants by 19,398.
