William F./Hynes is reknowned for his anti-labor work for the Los

Farmers. The Dies committee imows of his relations with fascist organizations.

Hynes has had connections with axis espionage services. But he worked for the committee in July 1938 and was paid by Dies with check no. 6833. Above Hynes'
