Kings County Alliance Urges \$150,000 More for Dies Group

The Kings County Allied War Veterans Committee, which represents seven major veterans' organizations, adopted yesterday at its annual meeting a resolution demanding that Congress continue the House Committee to Investigate Un-American Activities and appropriate \$150,000 for its use.

The resolution was submitted by the Kings County Council, Veterans of Foreign Wars, and presented by John Durrant, county commander, and Herman R. La Tourette, county adjutant. Copies will be sent to Brooklyn's Representatives and the two Senators from New York.

Colonel William A. Dawkins, former State commander of the United Spanish War Veterans, was re-elected chairman of the committee. Mr. Durrant was elected first vice chairman and Archie Greenberg, Brooklyn commander of the Jewish War Veterans, second vice chairman. Daniel Rodgers was re-elected secretary and Eugene Lee was elected treasurer.
