

Italian Planes Raid Gibraltar Again

LA LINEA, Spain, July 27 (AP).—
—Italian warplanes attacked Britain's Gibraltar fortress again last night in the second heavy bombing raid in less than 24 hours, apparently in an effort to drive British warships out of that stronghold.

There were no reliable reports that any warship was hit.

For 16 minutes bomb explosions and fire from Gibraltar's guns and warships rocked houses in La Linea and Algeciras, across a bay from the famous rock.

It was believed here that the reported toll of 4 dead and 37 injured in an early morning raid yesterday mounted higher with the second attack.
