From the New York Times November 19, 1939 (A.P. dispatch) Dies said that Communists planned "acts of sabotage and provocation of strikes \* \* \* This is one of the worst spots in the country. \* \* \* I am convinced that Communists hold some key positions in labor unions here."

Dies promised, "We'll name them (Moscow agents) and give details when he hold hearings here. He also said he had "undercover agents" working quietly in Pittsburgh for several months."
