Erward James Smythe, New York City, who with 27 other defendants was indicted by a Federal grand jury for conspiracy to lower the morale of the U.S. armed forces, operated out of Washington several years ago with former Air Rhid Warden Don-

washing ton several years ago with former Air Raid warden Don-ald Shea as his associate, The News learned today. So far U. S. attorneys have been unsuccessful in locating Smythe, the Justice Department admitted. If Smythe is located,, he will appear with the other defendants in a mass arraignment in District Court tomorrow.

Smythe is known as the organizer of the Protestant War Veterans and as columnist for "Publicity," Wichita, columnist for "Publicity," Wichita, Kan., publication, edited by E. J. Gar-ner, one of the men indicted. Garner was also indicted by a Federal grand jury in Kansas City on a sedition charge.

**HERE IN 1938** 

Edward Smythe was in Washington in 1938 when the Protestant War Veterans was organized on Oct. 14. Trustees were listed as Edward Smythe, Donald Shea and James T. Bleakely, and headquarters were at Shea's home at 2207 K-st nw.

In a letter over Smythe's signature, written July 28, 1939, on stationery of the Protestant War Veterans, the aims of the veterans were given. The letter was written to the Terramare Office was written to the Terramare Office in Berlin, Germany, camouflaged Nam propaganda office. The letter said "My thanks for the books on Hitler and the New Germany . . . I gave them away at meetings I was addressing on the subject of keeping America out of another alliance with Great Britain and going to war against Germany."

Germany." On April 7. 1939, Smythe and Shea with one Wilson Fumphrey are listed as having organized another of their carefully incorporated groups, the Protestant Chaplains Association with headquarters in Washington.

In August, 1939, when Smythe was called upon to explain his activities to the Dies Committee, Shea wrote a thumbnall sketch of Smythe's character and at-tacked him. When Shea on April 4, 1939, or-ganized the Melville Community Coun-cil and Junior Leage pledged to "de-fend and preserve the Constitution, Smythe was not among the founders. From New York Smythe was now carrying on the work of the Protest-ant War Veterans. On July 28, 1939, there was a letter over his signature to Herr H. R. S. It stated: "Americans will never fight German again. We were suckers in the World War for international Jewry, especially the House of Rothschild, but pray God never again." Herr Hoffmann was assured that the American people, and "not those of German descent alone," want to know what is really happening in Germany."
