GEORGIA BANS FASCISTI

Charter Denied Order Seeking Promotion of "white Suprembey"

ATLANTA, Oct. 17 (A. P.).—The American Radicisti Order of Black Shirts, which sought incorporation in Georgia and listed among its purposes promotion of "white supremacy," was denied a clarter in Fullon county court today Judge G., H. Howard, denying the charter, said some members of tile order apparently misunderstood the term "white supremacy" and sought a charter althorizing both legal and illegal acts.

The American Fascisti Order of Black Shirts, chartered at Orlando, Fla., and which interfened to oppose the charter for the Georia order, was enjoined from openting in Fulton county. Evidence at the hearing showed several Atlanta firms had received demands from the Black Shirts to discharge negro laborers and put white inen in their places.
