F. B. I. Finds No Hint of Sabotage in Blast

An authoritative source today said Federal agents have found no evidence of sabotage in the explosion of nitroglycerine at the Gibbstown, N. J., Dupont plant.

G-men were sent to the scene by Director J. Edgar Hoover of the Federal Bureau of Investigation immediately after the blast which killed two men and shook the surrounding area. The investigation is being continued, it was said.
