Royal Oak, Mich., April 16 (INS).—
Acting on orders from the postoffice in Washington, Royal Oak Postmaster Gilbert H. Davis today halted in the mails copies of Social Justice, a weekly publication founded by the Rev. Father Charles E. Coughlin.

Previously, Attorney General Francis Biddle had banned the publication from the mails on a charge of violation of the 1917 Espionage Act.

Davis refused to deliver 120 copies of the magazine which are sent from Royal Oak. One copy, he said, was sent to the Postmaster General in Washington for examination to determine whether it contained seditious matter.
