Last of 28 Sedition

The Justice Department announced today the arrest of Howard Victor Broenstrup, also known by numerous aliases, near New Galilee, Pa., as the last of the 28 persons indicted July 23 on sedition charges to be taken into custody.

The department said Broenstrup was arrested in a cottage by Federal Bureau of Investigation agents and Pennsylvania Motor Police.

J. Edgar Hoover, FBI director, said Broenstrup long had been known "as a distributor of anti-Semitic and divisionist literature," and that he had been closely allier with William Dudley Pelley, leade. of the Silver Shirt organization.
