Two Bund Officers Freed After Quiz In Pennsylvania

Reading, Pa., June 16, (P).—Two national officers of the German-American Bund, arrested by Pennsylvania State police here Friday for questioning, were released today.

They were idetnified by Sergt. Edward C. Sickel as Gerhard Wilhelm Kunze, 34, of New York, acting leader of the bund, and Gustav Joseph Elmer, 49, of Hoboken, N. J., secretary-treasurer.

Sickel said the men were taken into custody as they left "a public place to make the usual check on suspicious persons."

The officer added that copies of the bund's newspaper were seized from the pair's automobile, along with stickers reading "The Yanks Are Not Coming" and "John Bull Declared This War—Now God Save the King."
