Kuhn Loses Plea for Bail Pending Appeal

NEW YORK, Jan. 10.—The application of Fritz Kuhn, German-American Bund leader, for a certificate of reasonable doubt in his conviction on a larceny charge was denied today by Supreme Court Justice Charles B. McLaughlin.

Had the certificate been granted, Kuhn would have been eligible to be freed in bail, pending an appeal, from Sing Sing Prison, where he is serving a term of from two and one-half to five years.
