Bund Now Enrolls Its Sympathizers

Its fruity reputation is driving the pro-Nazi German American Bund deeper and deeper underground.

Latest step in the Bund's down-into-earth drive is attempted removal of the stigma of membership from its members, who are being registered as "sympathizers." They don't have to give their correct names and addresses.
