**DEPORTATION URGED  
FOR HITLERITES HERE**

**Untermeyer Declares Federal Of-  
ficials Are Investigating Nazi  
Propagandists.**

In a statement issued yesterday, following a meeting of the administrative committee of the American League for the Defense of Jewish Rights, held at his home, Grey-stone, in Yonkers, Samuel Untermyer, president of the league, announced that "complaints are being lodged and the immigration authorities being petitioned" to deport Nazi propagandists from this country.

The meeting was called to discuss means of raising a \$500,000 fund, which will be used by the league to prosecute a boycott of German goods in the United States in retaliation for the treatment of Jews by the Hitler régime in Germany. A subcommittee of the league's financial committee, headed by J. David Stern, Philadelphia publisher, was instructed to consider and report on the means to be utilized.

Mr. Untermyer, in his statement, deplored that "swarms of German propagandists have been permitted to infest our shores and are here to sow their vile creed against Jews," while "scientists, college professors and many other distinguished victims of the bigotry and fanaticism of these savages are being denied admittance to this country."
