Yorkville Riot Spurs Action to Curb U. S. Nazis

An Emergency Conference to decide upon the immediate action to be taken in answer to the attack of armed Nazi Storm Troopers upon American World War Veterans was called by the New York City Division of the American League for Peace and Democracy for Wednesday, April 27, at 112 E. 19th St., Room 704.

The American Legion, Jewish War Veterans, Veterans of Foreign Wars, Catholic War Veterans, Council of United States Veterans, Inc., the Order of Masons, Knights of Pythias, German Workers Clubs, German American League for Culture were a few of the many veteran, civic and fraternal organizations invited to attend.

The invitation read in part:

"This bloody dress rehearsal of the Nazis must be the last one upon our shores.

"Your presence at the Emergency Conference, Wednesday, April 27, is imperative vital both for your organization and for the principles of democracy that we know you hold dear."
