

Nazis Tout Ford As U. S. Fuehrer At Bund Meeting

NEW YORK (FP).—Expecting a repetition of the rioting at a recent similar meeting, a battery of press photographers and reporters and a heavy detail of police stood through an uneventful round of one-sided Fascist speeches at a rally of the Nazi German-American Bund. The audience of 800 heard a new note struck in the routing of anti-Jewish, anti-liberal harangues with the naming of Henry Ford, union-hating industrialist, as a candidate for the role of the coming American Hitler. Touting of the Dearborn union hater for the job of native dictator came from George A. Moriarty, introduced as an American Legion member and a former U. S. military intelligence officer.

"Henry Ford has done more for America than anybody in this country," the Nazi stooge declared. "He's the man to lead us." Revealing plans to circulate petitions calling upon Ford to take the helm of government, Moriarty ended a series of incitements by demanding of those "willing to fight for western civilization and for Jesus Christ to be ready when the time comes."

A high point in Moriarty's re-bling fulminations was the allegation that Leon Trotsky, exiled Soviet war-time leader, made secret trips from Mexico to the White House to plot the overthrow of American democracy.
