Nazis Prepare To Open Camp Despite Quiz

Swastikas flew from every rooftop of Camp Siegfried today in celebration of the formal opening tomorrow of the Bund's Summer camp.

Despite the pending Suffolk County Grand Jury investigation into Nazism, Henry Hauck, director of the camp, concluded preparations to welcome more than 20,000 men, women and children, members and guests of the German-American Volksbund.

KUHN TO ATTEND.

Fritz Kuhn, head of the national Nazi group, and his military staff have sent word to the camp they will be present tomorrow and will bring with them 500 storm troopers.

The Grand Jury will begin its investigation into Nazism this week with the hearing of a score of witnesses.

Indictments against the six directors of Camp Siegfried will be demanded by District Attorney Fred J. Munder, leading spirit in the county's war "against un-Americanism."
