Anti-Nazis Disavow 'Anti-Ism' Talk

SAN FRANCISCO, May 31.—The United Anti-Nazi Citizens Committee, comprising the groups that sponsored yesterday's anti-Nazi demonstration at the California Hall, today definitely disavowed itself from statements attributed to it in the press, expressing hostility to a whole series of "isms."

The alleged statement asserted said that it (whoever issued it) saw no difference at all in the program of Nazis and Communists and was equally opposed to both.

Said the Anti-Nazi Committee today: "No group connected with our organization authorized an such statement and none of the groups reputedly signing the statement had any connection with the demonstration, with the exception of the CIO and AFL Council whose signatures we question as they heartily endorsed and cooperated with our objectives in this demonstration."

"Our demonstration was organized with one objective—completely anti-Nazi, with no reference to other movements. The statement that the demonstration was against Communism is false. It was a genuine united front of all organizations opposed to Nazism."
